Our annual PTA Membership Drive will take place in September. More info will be coming home soon!



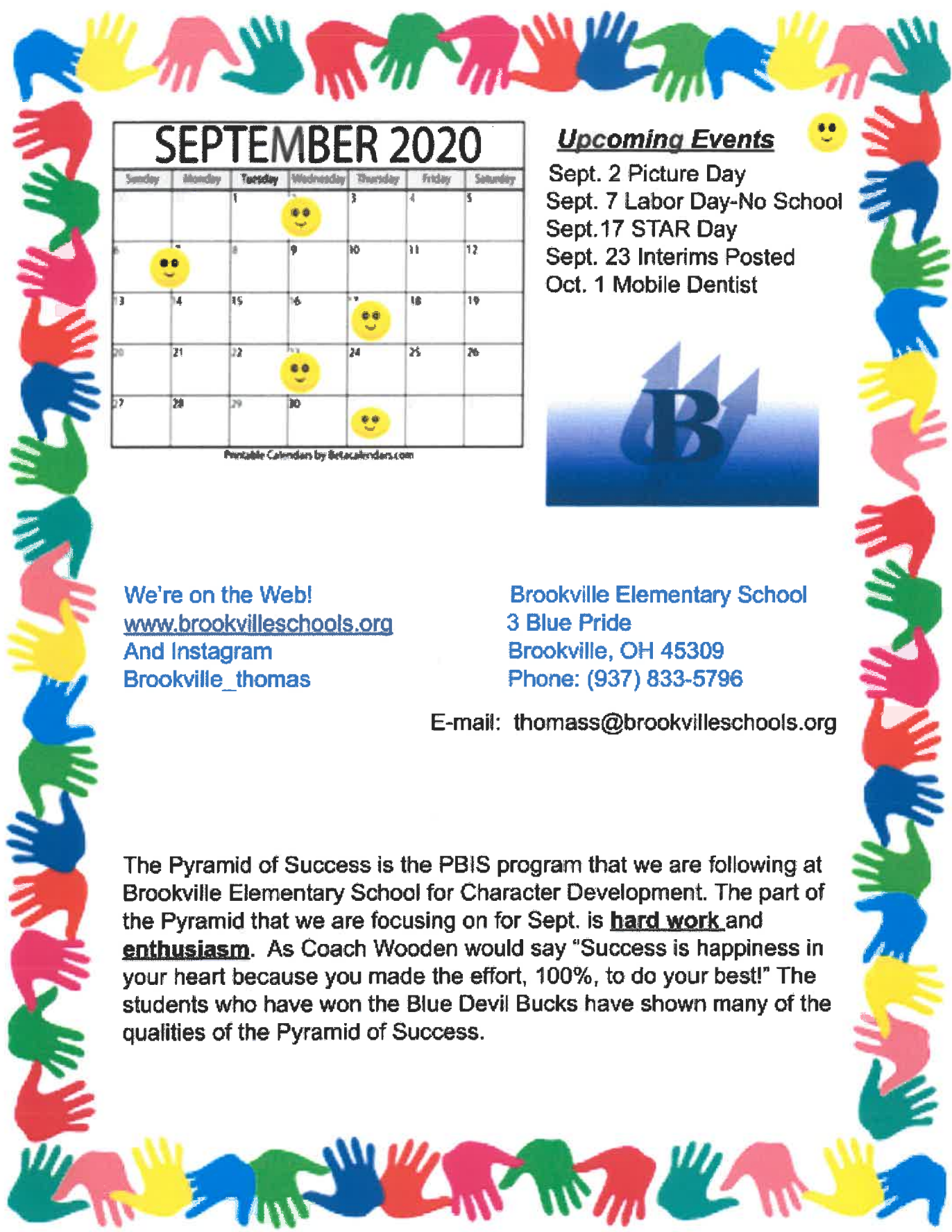
Birthday Party Treats
