BROOKVILLE HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

Purpose --

The purpose of the Brookville Athletic Hall of Fame is to honor individual athletes, coaches, athletic administrators, and those who have provided meritorious service to the athletic program.

Criteria --

- 1. All nominees must have excelled in athletics as a player, coach, athletic administrator, or by meritorious service to the Brookville athletic program.
- 2. All athlete nominees must wait five years after the class graduation date to become eligible.
- 3. All coach and athletic administrator nominees must have been a former employee of the Brookville Local Schools.
- 4. All meritorious service nominees must have made outstanding contributions over an extended period of time to the Brookville athletic program.
- 5. All nominees must have demonstrated good citizenship and character... a tradition at Brookville High School.

Nominations --

- 1. Any individual meeting the above qualifications may be nominated by anyone. Nominations that were considered for induction but were not inducted will be considered every year thereafter for a period of five years.
- 2. Nominations forms can be obtained in either the Superintendent's office or Athletic Director's office. Mail all nominations to the Athletic Director, Brookville High School, One Blue Pride Drive, Brookville, Ohio 45309.
- 3. Nominations should be received prior to October 1, of each year with selections finalized prior to November 30.

Selections --

- 1. Six candidates will be inducted the first three years and up to three candidates each subsequent year.
- 2. Inducted candidates will be honored at a ceremony preceding the start of a home basketball game.
- 3. Honorees will receive a plaque and each class of honorees will be honored on the wall outside of the gymnasium.

Selection Committee --

The committee will consist of eleven members:

High School Principal Athletic Director Athletic Booster's Club President An alumni graduating prior to 1948 An alumni graduating between the years of 1948 - 1958 An alumni graduating between the years of 1959 - 1969 An alumni graduating between the years of 1970 - 1980 An alumni graduating between the years of 1981 - 1991 An alumni graduating after 1992 to the present Two coaches at-large chosen by their colleagues

To provide continuity and experience, all terms shall be for a period of three (3) years. Replacement members will be selected by the committee members still serving. The committee will follow as closely as possible the structure of the original committee when selecting replacement members. The members of the selection committee shall elect a chairman to serve for a term of one (1) year. The individual serving as chairman may be re-elected at the pleasure of the committee, so long as the person selected is a member of the committee. The committee's primary duty shall be the screening of nominations and the selecting of entrants for the annual induction into the Hall of Fame.
